

Missionary & Child Sponsorship

You can take the Gospel of Jesus Christ into the unreached nations of the world by helping support a local missionary with an offering of **\$50-\$100/ month**. Total support varies depending on several factors: family size; type of ministry; region of the world; etc.

You can also sponsor a child in poorer countries with only **\$25/ month**. Many of these children will develop a passion for reaching their own people, as they grow older.

Global Commission Partners will send you a complete profile of your missionary or child, which will include a photo and biographical information. In addition, a report regarding their progress will be sent every six months.

What is Global Commission Partners?

Global Commission Partners is a non-profit missionary organization dedicated to evaluate and help support fruitful indigenous ministries. Missionaries that are native to an area, working with these ministries, already know the languages and cultures of the people to whom they are witnessing. All ministries helped by GCP are planting the Gospel of Jesus Christ among the remaining Unreached People Groups.

Our Mission

Our Lord Jesus Christ said, “And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all nations, and then the end will come.” Matthew 24:14. The word “**nations**” does not refer to countries. In the original Greek, the word is “**ethnos**” meaning ethno-linguistic groups.

Therefore, we seek to help western churches and individual Christians take the Gospel to the remaining unreached ethnic groups in the most cost effective way, by helping native ministries.

Our Vision

It is believed that there are still over 4,000 unreached ethnic groups in the world. This represents approximately 1/3 of the world’s population. These people are without a viable Gospel witness for Christ.

Once GCP evaluates and approves the ministries, we seek financial support to provide them with the essential tools they need to plant churches among these unreached groups, in order to finish the task.



Why Help Missionaries Native to an Area?

- Local missionaries have known their languages from birth, have mastered other dialects, and know their own culture intimately.
- They represent 90% of the most effective missionary force in the world regarding the task of evangelizing unreached people groups, but receive less than 10% of the resources necessary for the job.
- Most indigenous missionaries live at the same social and economic levels as the people to whom they are ministering.
- They cannot be deported because they are already citizens of their own country. In addition, governments tend to be less suspicious of citizens.
- A local missionary can be sponsored with a very small monthly amount.

Missionary Projects
